A BILL FOR l An Act requiring the labeling of Christmas trees and providing penalties. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 159.35 CHRISTMAS TREES.
- As used in this section, unless the context otherwise
- 3 requires, "Christmas tree" means a tree classified as a
- 4 conifer with persistent needles, that is sold to consumers on
- 5 a retail basis for use in celebrating or observing Christmas.
- 6 2. A precut Christmas tree shall not be sold in this state
- 7 on and after November 15 but before December 25 of each year,
- 8 unless a label containing information naming the state where
- 9 the Christmas tree was harvested is affixed to the tree. If
- 10 the Christmas tree is harvested in a nation other than the
- 11 United States, the label shall contain information stating the
- 12 nation where the Christmas tree was harvested.
- 3. The department shall adopt rules under chapter 17A
- 14 providing for standards relating to the preparation of labels
- 15 and information contained on the labels required in this
- 16 section.
- 17 4. A violation of this section or a rule adopted by the
- 18 department pursuant to this section is a violation of section
- 19 714.16. The remedies and penalties provided by section
- 20 714.16, including but not limited to provisions relating to
- 21 injunctive relief and penalties, apply to violations of this
- 22 section.
- 23 EXPLANATION
- 24 This bill regulates the sales of Christmas trees, which are
- 25 defined as a conifer with persistent needles, that is sold to
- 26 consumers on a retail basis for use in celebrating or
- 27 observing Christmas. The bill provides that a precut
- 28 Christmas tree shall not be sold in this state on and after
- 29 November 15 but before December 25 of each year, unless the
- 30 tree is affixed with a label containing information naming the
- 31 state where the Christmas tree was harvested. The bill
- 32 provides that if a Christmas tree is harvested in a nation
- 33 other than the United States, the label must contain
- 34 information stating the nation where the Christmas tree was
- 35 harvested. The department must adopt rules providing for

1 standards relating to the preparation of labels and 2 information contained on the labels as required in this 3 section. A violation of the bill or a rule adopted by the 4 department is a violation of section 714.16. The remedies and 5 penalties provided by section 714.16, including but not 6 limited to provisions relating to injunctive relief and 7 penalties, apply to violations of the bill.
