Section 1. Section 598.21, subsection 3, paragraph f, Code
 Supplement 1995, is amended to read as follows:

3 f. The feasibility of the party seeking maintenance
4 becoming self-supporting at a standard of living reasonably
5 comparable-to-that-enjoyed-during-the-marriage7-and-the-length
6 of-time-necessary-to-achieve-this-goal that is equitable under
7 the circumstances of the case.

EXPLANATION

9 This bill amends one of the factors to be considered by the 10 court in awarding support payments to either party to judgment 11 of annulment, dissolution, or separate maintenance. The 12 factor relating to self-support of the party currently takes 13 into consideration the standard of living comparable to that 14 enjoyed during the marriage and also takes into account the 15 period of time necessary to achieve the goal. The new 16 language would only allow consideration of a standard of 17 living which is equitable given the circumstances of the 18 individual case.
