A BILL FOR 1 An Act providing for the modification or termination of certain 2 trusts by the court. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 633.699A MODIFICATION OR
- 2 TERMINATION OF TRUST.
- 3 1. On petition by a trustee or beneficiary, the court may
- 4 modify the provisions of the trust or terminate the trust in
- 5 whole or in part if the continuation of the trust under its
- 6 terms would defeat or substantially impair the accomplishment
- 7 of the purposes of the trust, or if the purposes of the trust
- 8 have been fulfilled, or have become illegal or impossible to
- 9 fulfill.
- 10 a. The court may order the trustee to do acts that are not
- 11 authorized or are forbidden by the trust instrument, or may
- 12 order that the trustee be prohibited from performing acts that
- 13 are required by the terms of the trust.
- 14 b. The existence of a trust provision restraining transfer
- 15 of the beneficiary's interest does not prevent application of
- 16 this subsection.
- 2. On petition by a trustee or beneficiary, if the court
- 18 determines that the fair market value of a trust has become so
- 19 low in relation to the cost of administration that
- 20 continuation of the trust under its existing terms will defeat
- 21 or substantially impair the accomplishment of its purposes,
- 22 the court may, in its discretion, order termination of the
- 23 trust, modification of the trust, or appointment of a new

- 25 a. Notwithstanding subsection 2, if the trust principal
- 26 does not exceed twenty thousand dollars in value, the trustee
- 27 has the power to terminate the trust without petitioning the
- 28 court. However, the trustee may seek approval of the court,
- 29 or may seek instruction on issues related to terminating the
- 30 trust.
- 31 b. The existence of a trust provision restraining transfer
- 32 of the beneficiary's interest does not prevent application of
- 33 this subsection.
- 34 EXPLANATION
- 35 This bill adds a new section to the probate code pertaining

1 to modification or termination of trusts. The section 2 proposes that the court may modify or terminate a trust when 3 the enforcement of the terms of a trust is no longer 4 consistent with the purposes of the trust, or it is impossible 5 to continue the trust. A subsection of the proposed provision 6 expressly permits the court to modify or terminate a trust 7 that has become uneconomical to administer, and permits a 8 trustee to make this determination when the principal of the 9 trust is less than \$20,000.
