<u>1.</u> The director shall establish a farmer advisory
5 committee for the purpose of providing information to the
6 department regarding crop and tree damage caused by deer, wild
7 turkey, and other predators. The committee shall serve
8 without compensation or reimbursement for expenses.

9 2. A landowner may claim compensation from the state for 10 the actual damages caused by deer to the landowner's crops, 11 agricultural equipment, and other property related to 12 agricultural production. The claim shall be filed and 13 processed as provided in chapter 25. The wildlife damage 14 officer of the department of natural resources shall assist 15 the claimant and the special assistant attorney general for 16 claims under chapter 25 in determining the actual damages 17 caused by deer to the claimant's property.

## EXPLANATION

19 This bill provides that a landowner may claim compensation 20 from the state for actual damages caused by deer to the 21 landowner's crop, agricultural equipment, and other property 22 related to agricultural production. The wildlife damage 23 control officer of the department of natural resources shall 24 assist the claimant and the special assistant attorney general 25 for claims in determining the actual damages caused by the 26 deer.
