8 EXPLANATION
9 This bill adds a representative of the Iowa physician
10 assistant society and a representative of the Iowa association
11 of nurse practitioners to the membership of the council which
12 consults with the director of human services regarding medical
13 assistance. The bill also corrects the reference to the Iowa
14 hospital association which is now the association of Iowa

15 hospitals and health systems.
