16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill replaces a portion of the Code which defines the
18 practice of dentistry by including a directive to the board of
19 dental examiners to define the practice of dentistry and to
20 include in the definition certain acts, services, procedures,
21 and practices as the practice of dentistry.
