## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the membership of the council which provides
2 assistance to the director of human services regarding medical
3 assistance.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
5

Section 1. Section 249A.4, subsection 8, unnumbered 2 paragraph 1, Code 1995, is amended to read as follows: Shall advise and consult at least semiannually with a 4 council composed of the presidents of the following 5 organizations, or a president's representative who is a member 6 of the organization represented by the president: the Iowa 7 medical society, the Iowa osteopathic medical association, the 8 Iowa state dental society, the Iowa state nurses association, 9 the Iowa pharmacists association, the Iowa podiatry society, 10 the Iowa optometric association, the community mental health 11 centers association of Iowa, the Iowa psychological 12 association, the association of Iowa hospital-association 13 hospitals and health systems, the Iowa osteopathic hospital 14 association, opticians' association of Iowa, inc., the Iowa 15 hearing aid society, the Iowa speech, language, and hearing 16 association, the Iowa health care association, the Iowa 17 association for home care, the Iowa council of health care 18 centers, the Iowa physician assistant society, the Iowa 19 association of nurse practitioners, and the Iowa association 20 of homes for the aging, the Iowa psychiatric nurse managers 21 network, the arc of Iowa which was formerly known as the 22 association for retarded citizens of Iowa, the alliance for 23 the mentally ill of Iowa, Iowa state association of counties, 24 and the Iowa governor's planning council for developmental 25 disabilities, together with one person designated by the Iowa 26 state board of chiropractic examiners; one state 27 representative from each of the two major political parties 28 appointed by the speaker of the house, one state senator from 29 each of the two major political parties appointed by the 30 president of the senate, after consultation with the majority 31 leader and the minority leader of the senate, each for a term 32 of two years; four public representatives, appointed by the 33 governor for staggered terms of two years each, none of whom 34 shall be members of, or practitioners of, or have a pecuniary 35 interest in any of the professions or businesses represented

1 by any of the several professional groups and associations 2 specifically represented on the council under this subsection, 3 and at least one of whom shall be a recipient of medical 4 assistance; the director of public health, or a representative 5 designated by the director; and the dean of the college of 6 medicine, university of Iowa, or a representative designated 7 by the dean. EXPLANATION This bill adds a representative of the Iowa physician 10 assistant society and a representative of the Iowa association 11 of nurse practitioners to the membership of the council which 12 consults with the director of human services regarding medical 13 assistance.
