1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 476.58 TELEPHONE SOLICITATIONS
2 PROHIBITED -- PENALTY.

1. A person shall not knowingly solicit another person at 4 that person's place of employment through the use of a 5 telephone or facsimile machine for the sale of goods or 6 services in this state, other than for the sale of goods or 7 services which are used by or related to the business of the 8 person's place of employment. A violation of this subsection 9 is a serious misdemeanor.

10 2. The board shall adopt rules implementing this section 11 and providing for the use of caller identification services 12 for determining the origin of a call which is in violation of 13 this section at no charge to the person receiving the call. 14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill prohibits the knowing solicitation of another 16 person at that person's place of employment through the use of 17 a telephone or facsimile machine for the sale of goods or 18 services in this state, other than for the sale of goods or 19 services which are used by or related to the business of the 20 person's place of employment. A violation of this subsection 21 is a serious misdemeanor.
