1 An Act providing for state reimbursement of certain costs
2 incurred by counties concerning persons on parole.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 331.427, subsection 1, unnumbered
2 paragraph 1, Code Supplement 1995, is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 Except as otherwise provided by state law, county revenues
5 from taxes and other sources for general county services shall
6 be credited to the general fund of the county, including
7 revenues received under sections 101A.3, 101A.7, 123.36,
8 123.143, 142B.6, 176A.8, 321.105, 321.152, 321G.7, 331.554,
9 subsection 6, 341A.20, 364.3, 368.21, 422.65, 422A.2, 428A.8,
10 430A.3, 433.15, 434.19, 445.57, 453A.35, 458A.21, 483A.12,
11 533.24, 556B.1, 567.10, 583.6, 602.8108, 904.908, and 906.17,
12 and 908.12, and chapter 405A, and the following:

13 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 908.12 COUNTY REIMBURSEMENT
14 CONCERNING PERSONS ON PAROLE.

15 1. To the extent reimbursement is not received pursuant to
16 section 906.17, the Iowa department of corrections shall
17 reimburse a county for the following costs incurred by a
18 county pursuant to this chapter:

19 a. Costs incurred in transporting a person on parole for
20 purposes of a parole revocation hearing or a criminal case in
21 which the person is a defendant.

22 b. Costs incurred in temporarily confining a person on
23 parole during the pendency of a parole revocation hearing or a
24 criminal case in which the person is a defendant.

25 2. Payment under this section shall be made upon
26 submission of a voucher executed by the county sheriff and
27 approved by the director of the Iowa department of
28 corrections.

29 EXPLANATION

30 This bill provides that a county shall obtain reimbursement
31 from the state department of corrections for transportation
32 and incarceration costs a county incurs as a result of a
33 parole revocation hearing or a criminal case involving a
34 person on parole.
