BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. MOTORBOATS OPERATING ON BIG CREEK LAKE -- TEMPORARY.

1. Notwithstanding section 462A.31, subsection 1, paragraph "b", a motorboat equipped with any power unit mounted or carried aboard the vessel may be operated at a nowake speed on Big Creek lake. However, the use of jet skis and the towing of flotation recreational equipment are prohibited on Big Creek lake.

This section applies to artificial lakes from May 24,
 through September 2, 1996, both dates inclusive.

3. This section is repealed effective September 3, 1996.
