1 Section 1. Section 88B.1, Code 1995, is amended by adding

8 88B.2 PERMIT REQUIRED -- APPLICATION, QUALIFICATIONS, AND

10 1. To qualify for a permit, a business entity shall submit

12 division and pay the prescribed fee.

14 business entity shall not engage engaging in the removal or

EXPLANATION

11 This bill reorders chapter 88B of the Iowa Code, the
12 asbestos removal and encapsulation chapter, permits the
13 division of labor services of the department of employment
14 services to deny a permit or license to an individual or
15 business entity, or, in the case of a training institution,
16 the department of education may deny accreditation, for
17 circumstances for which the departments may currently suspend
18 or revoke a permit, license, or training authorization. To
19 meet federal requirements, the bill also expands the training
20 requirements and applies licensing provisions beyond those
21 asbestos abatement workers working in schools to those working
22 in public and commercial buildings.

23 Under current law, the labor commissioner is permitted to
24 base fees for the issuance and renewal of licenses and permits
25 for asbestos removal and encapsulation on the costs of
26 administering the chapter. The bill stipulates that the costs
27 of administering the chapter include the time spent by
28 personnel of the division in performing duties and travel
29 expenses incurred.

30 Much of the language in the bill is current law, but the
31 language has been repositioned without significantly altering
32 the language. However, current law places the responsibility
33 of approving training courses on the department of education.
34 The bill strikes language that authorizes the department of
35 education to reprimand a training institution or suspend or

1 revoke a training institution authorization, and repeals a
2 section requiring the department to approve training courses.
3 The bill also provides that an applicant must successfully
4 complete training as established by the United States
5 environmental protection agency to qualify for a license.

9 BACKGROUND STATEMENT

10 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

11 Congress reauthorized the Asbestos School Hazard Abatement
12 Reauthorization Act of 1990 in 1994, and extended the law that
13 previously only covered school buildings to include public and
14 commercial buildings. It also requires states to upgrade the
15 training requirements that individuals must receive to work in
16 asbestos abatement.

17 Currently, asbestos licenses are available to individuals
18 and permits to businesses, but the license and permit
19 requirements are mixed within chapter 88B. The department of
20 education approves the training program for asbestos abatement
21 workers in the school systems. No one accredits training
22 programs for public and commercial buildings.
