2 1. Page 1, by striking lines 8 through 13 and
3 inserting the following: "reference. However, if all
4 of the following conditions exist, the administrative
5 rules coordinator may waive the requirement provided
6 by this subsection:
7 a. The cost of the publication is an unreasonable
8 expense when compared to the anticipated usage of the
9 publication.
10 b. A copy of the publication is available from an
11 entity located within the state capitol complex.
12 c. The rule adopting a standard by reference to
13 another publication identifies the location where the
14 other publication is available."

8 reference. However, if the purchase of a copy of the
9 publication containing the standards would be an unreasonable
10 expense and the state law library can temporarily and promptly
11 obtain a copy of the publication upon receiving a request, the
12 administrative rules coordinator may waive the requirement of
13 this subsection.

14 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
15 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill amends a requirement in section 17A.6, relating
18 to publications under the administrative procedures Act.
19 Section 17A.6 requires an agency which adopts standards by
20 reference to another publication to purchase the publication
21 and provide it to the administrative rules coordinator for
22 deposit in the state law library. The bill authorizes the
23 administrative rules coordinator to waive the requirement if
24 the purchase of the publication is an unreasonable expense and
25 the state law library can temporarily and promptly obtain a
26 copy of the publication upon receiving a request.
