Section 1. Section 99B.7, Code 1995, is amended by adding 1 2 the following new subsection: Upon application and payment of a fee 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 8. 4 of fifteen dollars, the department shall issue a bingo 5 contract permit to a qualified organization. 6 contract permit authorizes a qualified organization to 7 contract with a person licensed to conduct bingo under this 8 chapter to conduct an annual bingo occasion on behalf of the 9 qualified organization. A bingo licensee shall conduct the 10 contract bingo occasion at the location where the licensee 11 normally conducts bingo games. The bingo contract permit 12 authorizes the conduct of only one bingo occasion per year for 13 the qualified organization. However, a bingo occasion 14 pursuant to this subsection may exceed four hours. 15 qualified organization shall distribute the net receipts of 16 the annual bingo occasion in compliance with this section. 17 EXPLANATION 18 This bill authorizes a person who is licensed to conduct 19 bingo games under chapter 99B to contract with a qualified 20 organization to conduct an annual bingo occasion on behalf of 21 the qualified organization. The qualified organization is 22 eligible to contract for the bingo occasion only once per year 23 and the net receipts from the bingo occasion shall be 24 distributed in compliance with the charitable, patriotic, 25 educational, public, or religious purpose of the qualified 26 organization. A violation of chapter 99B is punishable as a 27 serious misdemeanor, which means a fine of at least \$250 but 28 not more than \$1,000, or imprisonment for not more than one 29 year. 30 31 32 33
