EXPLANATION

8 This bill provides that the director of the department of
9 natural resources reserve 10 nonresident wild turkey hunting
10 licenses and 10 nonresident deer hunting licenses to be
11 allocated by a committee to foreign guests and dignitaries
12 visiting Iowa. The committee consists of the president of the
13 senate, speaker of the house of representatives, and director
14 of the department of economic development, or their designees.
15 The purpose of the reserved licenses is to allow state
16 officials to promote this state and its natural resources
17 through a hunting experience.

18 The licenses are to be issued without application, upon
19 payment of the nonresident license fee and the wildlife
20 habitat stamp fee and the licenses are valid in all zones open
21 to hunting. The hunter safety and ethics certification
22 requirements are waived for these licenses. Except as
23 otherwise provided in the subsections, the special licenses
24 issued are subject to all other provisions of the laws and
25 rules pertaining to the taking of wild turkey or deer.

HOUSE FILE 2401
FISCAL NOTE

A fiscal note for Amendment H-5169 to House File 2401 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Amendment H-5169 to House File 2401 adds lifetime hunting, fishing and combination hunting and fishing licenses for residents who are permanently disabled or sixty-five years of age or older.

ASSUMPTIONS

1. The number of permanently disabled residents cannot be determined, but is not expected to have a large impact on the Fish and Game Fund.
2. The average sales of lifetime fishing license for 1979-1984 was 8,300 licenses per year.
3. The average sales of lifetime hunting license for 1979-1984 was 115 licenses per year.
4. The average sales of lifetime combination hunting and fishing licenses for 1979-1984 was 603 licenses per year.
5. The average hunter or angler would continue actively hunting or fishing for seven years after age 65, which is the midpoint of the life expectancy tables in the Code of Iowa.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact of Amendment H-5169 to House File 2401 to the Fish and Game Protection Fund over a seven-year period for residents who purchase lifetime licenses would be a decrease of \$1.2 million.

The following reflects the revenue to the Fish and Game Fund for residents who purchase lifetime licenses:
