1 Section 1. Section 232.22, subsection 1, Code 1995, is
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. f. A dispositional order has been entered
4 under section 232.52 placing the child in detention.

5 Sec. 2. Section 232.52, subsection 2, Code 1995, is
6 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

7 NEW PARAGRAPH. g. An order placing a child in detention
8 for a specified period of time in a facility under section
9 232.22, subsection 2.

EXPLANATION

11 This bill provides that the juvenile court may enter a
12 dispositional order placing a juvenile who has been
13 adjudicated delinquent in detention for a specified period of
14 time. The juvenile may be detained in any facility in which a
15 juvenile who is taken into custody for an alleged delinquent
16 act could be detained.

17 This bill may contain a state mandate under chapter 25B.
18 If the bill contains a state mandate, a political subdivision
19 is not required to comply with the provisions of the bill
20 unless an appropriation fully or proportionately funding the
21 state's share of the costs to the political subdivision of
22 complying with the bill is made in accordance with section
23 25B.2, subsection 3.
