1 Section 1. The results of a special census conducted in
2 1995 and filed with the secretary of state for certification
3 after December 31, 1995, shall be considered timely for
4 purposes of determining population-based allocations of funds

12 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
13 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill provides that a city or county which undertook a
16 special census in 1995 for the purposes of determining the
17 allocation of population-based road use tax funds (section
18 312.3) or personal property tax replacement funds (section
19 405A.3) and which was prevented from filing the special census
20 results with the secretary of state by December 31, 1995, due
21 to a federal government shutdown shall have the census results
22 considered timely filed if the results are filed with the
23 secretary of state within 30 days of the effective date of
24 this bill. The bill takes effect upon enactment.

RELATING TO SPECIAL CENSUS CERTIFICATION AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. The results of a special census conducted in 1995 and filed with the secretary of state for certification after December 31, 1995, shall be considered timely for purposes of determining population-based allocations of funds under section 312.3, subsection 2, or section 405A.3 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1996, and subsequent fiscal years, if the special census results could not have been obtained for filing prior to December 31, 1995, due to federal offices being closed and if the special census results are filed by the governing body of the city with the secretary of state within 30 days of the effective date of this Act.
