1 Section 1. Section 483A.1, subsection 1, Code 1995, is
2 amended by adding the following new lettered paragraph:

3 NEW LETTERED PARAGRAPH. e. Lifetime license for legal
4 residents permanently disabled or sixty-five years of age or
5 older \$ 25.00

6 Sec. 2. Section 483A.1, subsection 2, Code 1995, is
7 amended by adding the following new lettered paragraph:

8 NEW LETTERED PARAGRAPH. g. Lifetime hunting license for
9 legal residents permanently disabled or sixty-five years of
10 age or older \$ 25.00

11 Sec. 3. Section 483A.1, subsection 3, Code 1995, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 3. Hunting and fishing combined licenses:

14 a. Legal residents except as otherwise provided .. \$ 23.50

15 b. Lifetime license for residents permanently disabled or
16 sixty-five years of age or older \$ 50.00

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill establishes a lifetime fishing license, a
19 lifetime hunting license, and a combined lifetime hunting and
20 fishing license for permanently disabled residents and for
21 residents who are 65 years of age or older. The fees for the
22 lifetime licenses are \$25.00 for fishing, \$25.00 for hunting,
23 and \$50.00 for the combined hunting and fishing.
