1 Section 1. Section 80B.11, Code 1995, is amended by adding
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 10. Examination process for law enforce-
4 ment officers who receive legitimate law enforcement training
5 in another state and who seek to become certified in Iowa.
6 The process shall provide the person with the opportunity to
7 demonstrate the skills and aptitude necessary for
8 certification. The director shall define "legitimate law
9 enforcement training" by rule and may set fees to cover the
10 costs of the examination process.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill provides that a person who has received
13 legitimate law enforcement training in another state may be
14 certified as a peace officer in Iowa through an examination
15 process through the Iowa law enforcement academy. The
16 examination process, the fees necessary to cover its costs,
17 and the definition of "legitimate law enforcement training"
18 are to be determined by the adoption of administrative rules.
