## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the election of the board of directors for an 2 area education agency and providing effective date and 3 applicability provisions.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 273.8, subsection 1, Code 1995, is 2 amended to read as follows:
3 1. BOARD OF DIRECTORS. The board of directors of an area 4 education agency shall consist of not less than five nor more 5 than nine members, each a resident of and elected in the 6 manner provided in this section from a director district that 7 is approximately equal in population to the other director 8 districts in the area education agency. Each direetor member 9 shall serve a three-year term which commences at the

## 10 organization meeting. A member may serve on the board of

11 directors who is a member of a board of directors of a school
12 district if the member is a qualified elector and resident of
13 the area education agency director district.
14 Sec. 2. Section 273.8, subsection 2, Code 1995, is amended 15 by striking the subsection and inserting in lieu thereof the 16 following:
17 2. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. Regular elections held annually 18 by the area education agency for the election of members of 19 the board of directors shall be held on the date of the school 20 election as fixed by section 277.1. The election notice shall
21 be made a part of the local school election notice published 22 as provided in section 49.53 in each local school district 23 where voting is to occur in the area education agency election 24 and the election shall be conducted by the county commissioner 25 of elections pursuant to chapters 39 through 53 and section 26 277.20.
27 A candidate for member of the board of directors of an area 28 education agency shall be nominated by a petition signed by 29 not less than fifty eligible electors of the director district 30 from which the member is to be elected. The petition shall 31 state the number of the director district from which the 32 candidate seeks election, and the candidate's name and status 33 as an eligible elector of the director district. Signers of 34 the petition, in addition to signing their names, shall show 35 their residence, including street and number if any, the

school district in which they reside, and the date they signed the petition. A person may sign nomination petitions for more than one candidate for the same office, and the signature is not invalid solely because the person signed nomination petitions for one or more other candidates for the office. The petition shall include the affidavit of the candidate being nominated, stating the candidate's name and residence, and that the individual is a candidate, is eligible for the office sought, and if elected will qualify for the office.

Nomination papers on behalf of candidates for member of the board of directors of an area education agency shall be filed with the secretary of the area education agency board not 13 earlier than sixty-five days nor later than five p.m. on the 14 fortieth day prior to the election at which members of the 15 board are to be elected. The secretary shall deliver all 16 nomination petitions filed to the county commissioner of 17 elections who is responsible under section 47.2 for conducting 18 elections held for the area education agency not later than 19 five p.m. on the day following the last day on which 20 nomination petitions can be filed. That commissioner shall
21 certify the names of candidates to all county commissioners of 22 elections in the area education agency by the thirty-fifth day 23 prior to the election.
24 The votes cast in the election shall be canvassed and 25 abstracts of the votes cast shall be certified as required by 26 section 277.20 . In each county whose commissioner of
27 elections is responsible under section 47.2 for conducting 28 elections held for an area education agency, the county board 29 of supervisors shall convene on the last Monday in September 30 or at the last regular board meeting in September, canvass the 31 abstracts of votes cast and declare the results of the voting. 32 The commissioner shall at once issue certificates of election 33 to each person declared elected.

Successors shall be chosen at the annual school elections for members of the board of directors whose terms expire.

1 Vacancies on the board shall be filled at the next regular 2 meeting of the board by appointment by the remaining members of the board. A member so chosen shall be a resident of the district in which the vacancy occurred and shall serve until a member is elected pursuant to section 69.12 to fill the vacancy for the balance of the unexpired term. A vacancy is defined in section 277.29.

Sec. 3. Section 273.8 , subsection 5 , Code 1995, is amended to read as follows:
5. CHANGE IN DIRECTORS. The board of an area education

4 Act takes effect July 1,1995 , and is applicable to the school

9 Successors shall be elected as provided in this Act.
10 Vacancies occurring on the board on or after July 1, 1995,
11 shall be filled as provided in this Act.

EXPLANATION
13 This bill replaces the current method for electing the
14 members of the board of directors for an area education
15 agency, with the method used to elect members of the board of
16 directors of a merged area.
17 Currently, members of the board of directors of an area 18 education agency are elected at director district conventions 19 by members of the boards of directors of local school

20 districts located within the area education agency director
21 district.
22 Under the bill, members of the board of directors of an
23 area education agency would be elected at the regular
24 elections held annually by the area education agency on the 25 date of the school election.

26 A candidate for member of the board of directors of an area 27 education agency shall be nominated by a petition signed by 28 not less than 50 eligible electors of the director district 29 from which the member is to be elected. The secretary shall 30 deliver all nomination petitions filed to the county

31 commissioner of elections who is responsible for conducting
32 elections held for the area education agency. In each county
33 whose commissioner of elections is responsible for conducting
34 elections held for an area education agency, the county board
35 of supervisors shall convene on the last Monday in September
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l or at the last regular board meeting in September, canvass the 2 abstracts of votes cast, and declare the results of the 3 voting. The commissioner shall at once issue certificates of 4 election to each person declared elected.
5 Successors for members of the board of directors whose
6 terms expire shall be chosen at the annual school elections.
7 Vacancies on the board shall be filled at the next regular
8 meeting of the board by appointment by the remaining members
9 of the board. A member so chosen shall be a resident of the 10 district in which the vacancy occurred and shall serve until a member is elected to fill the vacancy for the balance of the unexpired term. A member who is a member of a board of directors of a local school district may serve on the board of directors of the area education agency.

15 The bill contains effective date and applicability
16 provisions. It takes effect July 1,1995 , for the school
17 election in September 1996, and members of area education
18 agency boards will continue in office until the expiration of their terms.
