## A BILL FOR

1 An Act pertaining to aging programs and services administered by the department of elder affairs and making an appropriation. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: 

231.34 AREA AGENCIES 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 2 APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated from the general fund of the 3 4 state to the department of elder affairs for the 5 administration of aging programs and services such additional 6 funding as is necessary to raise the statewide funding level 7 distributed to the area agencies on aging to three million 8 dollars annually. The department shall allocate all moneys appropriated 9 10 by this section above the funding level for the fiscal year 11 beginning July 1, 1989, and ending June 30, 1990, to the area 12 agencies on aging, without using any of the moneys for 13 administrative costs or developing any new program initiatives 14 unless developed locally through the area plan process. 15 **EXPLANATION** 16 This bill provides for a standing appropriation of up to 17 \$3,000,000 to the Iowa department of elder affairs to be used 18 for the aging programs and services administered by the area 19 agencies on aging. None of the moneys representing the 20 difference between the proposed funding level of \$3,000,000 21 and the amount appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 22 1, 1989, and ending June 30, 1990, shall be used for 23 administrative costs or developing any new programs unless the 24 programs are developed locally through the area plan process. 25 27 28
