1 Section 1. Section 331.904, subsection 2, Code 1995, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 2. Each deputy sheriff shall receive an annual base salary  
4 as determined by the ~~board~~ sheriff. Upon certification by the  
5 sheriff, if the salary of each deputy does not exceed the  
6 limitations specified in this subsection, the board shall  
7 ~~review, and may modify,~~ certify the annual base salary of each  
8 deputy ~~before certifying it~~ to the auditor. The annual base  
9 salary of a first or second deputy sheriff shall not exceed  
10 eighty-five percent of the annual base salary of the sheriff.  
11 The annual base salary of any other deputy sheriff shall not  
12 exceed the annual base salary of the first or second deputy  
13 sheriff except that in counties over two hundred fifty  
14 thousand population, the annual base salary of any additional  
15 deputies shall not exceed seventy-five percent of the annual  
16 base salary of the sheriff. The board shall not certify a  
17 deputy's salary which exceeds the limitations of this  
18 subsection. As used in this subsection, "base salary" means  
19 the basic compensation excluding overtime pay, longevity pay,  
20 shift differential pay, or other supplemental pay and fringe  
21 benefits.

22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill provides that the annual base salary of each  
24 deputy sheriff shall be determined by the sheriff within the  
25 limitations specified by law. Currently, the board of  
26 supervisors determines the annual base salaries of the deputy  
27 sheriffs. However, the annual salaries of deputy auditors,  
28 treasurers, and recorders are determined by their principal  
29 officers.
