1 An Act relating to the annual salaries of the members of the
2 utilities board and providing an applicability provision.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. 1994 Iowa Acts, chapter 1191, section 4,
2 subsections 6 and 11, are amended to read as follows:

3 6. The following are range 5 positions: ~~chairperson-and~~
4 ~~members-of-the-utilities-board,~~ consumer advocate, job service
5 commissioner, labor commissioner, industrial commissioner,
6 commissioner of insurance, administrator of the historical
7 division of the department of cultural affairs, administrator
8 of the public broadcasting division of the department of
9 education, the administrator of the state racing and gaming
10 commission of the department of inspections and appeals,
11 commandant of the veterans home, and secretary of the state
12 fair board.

13 11. The following are range 9 positions: director of the
14 department of education, director of human services, director
15 of the department of economic development, executive director
16 of the state board of regents, director of the state
17 department of transportation, lottery commissioner,
18 chairperson and members of the utilities board, the state
19 court administrator, and the director of the department of
20 management.

21 Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. Section 1 of this Act applies to
22 the annual salaries for the chairperson and members of the
23 utilities board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995,
24 and for subsequent fiscal years until otherwise provided by
25 the general assembly.

26 EXPLANATION

27 This bill assigns the chairperson and members of the
28 utility board to salary range 9, which has a minimum salary of
29 \$72,600 and a maximum salary of \$102,900. Currently, the
30 chairperson and members of the utility board are assigned to
31 the salary range 5, which has a minimum salary of \$57,400 and
32 a maximum salary of \$73,900. The bill applies to the fiscal
33 year beginning July 1, 1995, and subsequent fiscal years until
34 otherwise provided by the general assembly.
