A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to limitations on legislators' expenses of
2 office, and providing an effective date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 2.10, subsection 1, Code 1995, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. Every member of the general assembly except the
4 presiding officer of the senate, the speaker of the house, the
5 majority and minority floor leader of each house, and the
6 president pro tempore of the senate and speaker pro tempore of
7 the house, shall receive an annual salary of eighteen thousand
8 eight hundred dollars for the year 1995 and subsequent years
9 while serving as a member of the general assembly. In
10 addition, each such member shall receive the sum of sixty
11 dollars per day for expenses of office, except travel, for
12 each day the general assembly is in session commencing with
13 the first day of a legislative session and ending with the day
14 of final adjournment of each legislative session as indicated
15 by the journals of the house and senate, except that if the
16 length of the first regular session of the general assembly
17 exceeds one hundred ~~ten~~ calendar days and the second regular
18 session exceeds one-hundred ninety calendar days, the payments
19 shall be made only for one hundred ~~ten~~ calendar days for the
20 first session and one-hundred ninety calendar days for the
21 second session. However, members from Polk county shall
22 receive forty-five dollars per day. Each member shall receive
23 a one hundred twenty-five dollar per month allowance for
24 legislative district constituency postage, travel, telephone
25 costs, and other expenses. Travel expenses shall be paid at
26 the rate established by section 18.117 for actual travel in
27 going to and returning from the seat of government by the
28 nearest traveled route for not more than ~~one time per week~~
29 during a legislative session. However, any increase from time
30 to time in the mileage rate established by section 18.117
31 shall not become effective for members of the general assembly
32 until the convening of the next general assembly following the
33 session in which the increase is adopted; and this provision
34 shall prevail over any inconsistent provision of any present
35 or future statute.
