A BILL FOR

1 An Act making a contingent appropriation to the department of  
2 education to support programs for four-year-old at-risk  
3 children and providing for an effective date.

1 Section 1. AT-RISK CHILDREN. For the fiscal year  
2 beginning July 1, 1995, and ending June 30, 1996, the  
3 appropriation made to the department of education pursuant to  
4 section 279.51, subsection 1, shall be increased by  
5 \$2,500,000. The moneys appropriated in this section shall be  
6 allocated to the child development coordinating council as  
7 provided in section 279.51, subsection 1, paragraph "b", for  
8 purposes of section 279.51, subsection 2, paragraph "b",  
9 subparagraph (1). However, the moneys appropriated under this  
10 subsection shall be used only for programs established for  
11 four-year-old at-risk children.

12 Sec. 2. CONTINGENT APPROPRIATION. If the actual taxable  
13 valuation of real property located in this state, based upon  
14 January 1, 1994, assessments, which valuation is used in the  
15 computation of property taxes payable in the fiscal year  
16 beginning July 1, 1995, increases from the estimate of such  
17 taxable valuation, the amount of the reduction in state  
18 foundation aid under section 257.1 as a result of the increase  
19 in taxable valuation shall be used to fund section 1 of this  
20 Act.

21 Sec. 3. CONTINGENT EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 1 of this Act  
22 takes effect upon the enactment of section 2.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill makes a contingent appropriation of \$2.5 million  
25 to the department of education and allocates the funds to the  
26 child development coordinating council for purposes of  
27 providing grants to programs established for four-year-old at-  
28 risk children. The appropriation is contingent on the  
29 realization of projections that the state will pay less in  
30 school aid during fiscal year 1996 because of the increase in  
31 taxable property valuations over initial estimates.
