1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 256.91 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
2 EDUCATIONAL GRANTS.

3 1. An area education agency or a community college or
4 other educational institution which provides programs in
5 cooperation with manufacturing businesses, labor
6 organizations, service businesses, retail establishments, and
7 governmental entities to implement total quality management
8 principles to educational institutions, businesses, and
9 government shall be eligible for an economic development
10 educational grant of up to fifty thousand dollars to be used
11 for the purposes of the programs. The department shall
12 coordinate this program with the quality futures project
13 contained in Senate File 266, section 1, subsection 11, if
14 enacted.

15 2. An educational institution seeking a grant shall apply
16 to the department. The department shall determine whether the
17 educational institution is eligible for a grant and in what
18 amount. Eligibility shall be based on whether the grant
19 proposal is for a program which combines the resources of an
20 area education agency, community college, or educational
21 institution and the experience of the agency, college, or
22 institution in managing and operating a joint training network
23 involving public and private entities.

24 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of the
25 state to the department of education for the fiscal year
26 beginning July 1, 1995, and ending June 30, 1996, the
27 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be
28 used for the purpose designated:

29 For economic development educational grants:
30 \$ 500,000

31 EXPLANATION

32 This bill authorizes the department of education to award
33 economic development educational grants to area education
34 agencies, community colleges, or other educational institu-
35 tions to provide cooperative training on implementing total

1 quality management principles to educational institutions,
2 businesses, and government entities. Each grant may be up to
3 \$50,000. The bill also appropriates \$500,000 to the
4 department of education for this purpose, and requires the
5 grant program be coordinated with the quality futures program,
6 if enacted.
