AN ACT

AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE AMOUNT OF TAXES DEDICATED TO THE RESERVE ACCOUNT BY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES FOR SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT RELATED TO FIRE PROTECTION, EMERGENCY WARNING SYSTEMS, AND AMBULANCE SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 359.43, subsection 4, Code 1995, is amended to read as follows:

4. Of the levies authorized under subsections 1 and 2, the township trustees may credit to a reserve account annually an amount not to exceed ten thirty cents per thousand dollars of the assessed value of the taxable property in the township for the purchase or replacement of supplies and equipment required to carry out the services specified under section 359.42. Notwithstanding section 12C.7, interest earned on moneys
