A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the establishment of the state percent of
2 growth for purposes of the state school foundation program and
3 providing an effective and applicability date provision.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 257.8, subsection 1, Code 1995, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. STATE PERCENT OF GROWTH. The state percent of growth
4 for the budget year beginning July 1, 1996, is three and
5 three-tenths percent. The state percent of growth for a each
6 subsequent budget year shall be established by statute which
7 shall be enacted within thirty days of the submission in the
8 year preceding the base year of the governor's budget under
9 section 8.21. The establishment of the state percent of
10 growth for a budget year shall be the only subject matter of
11 the bill which enacts the state percent of growth for a budget
12 year.

13 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the subject matter restriction in
14 section 257.8, subsection 1, it is the intent of the general
15 assembly that with enactment of this Act that the
16 technology/school improvement program will be in existence and
17 funds will be appropriated for the program for school
18 districts and area education agencies for the school budget
19 year beginning July 1, 1996.

20 Sec. 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 1996, for school
21 budget years beginning after that date.

22 EXPLANATION

23 The bill sets the state percent of growth under the state
24 school foundation aid program at 3.3 percent for the budget
25 year beginning July 1, 1996. The bill provides that the state
26 percent of growth for subsequent budget years be set in the
27 year preceding the base year. This is a year sooner than
28 under present law.

29 The bill expresses the intent of the general assembly that
30 the technology/school improvement program be in existence and
31 funds for the program be appropriated for school districts and
32 area education agencies for the 1996-1997 fiscal year.

33 The bill takes effect January 1, 1996, for school budget
34 years beginning after that date.
