1 Section 1. Section 19A.3, Code 1995, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 23. Up to six nonprofessional employees  
4 designated at the discretion of each statewide elected  
5 official.

6 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 19A.3A EMPLOYEES OF STATEWIDE  
7 ELECTED OFFICIALS.

8 The exempt position classifications of employees of  
9 statewide elected officials as of June 30, 1994, shall remain  
10 exempt and any employees subsequently hired to fill any exempt  
11 position vacancies shall be classified as exempt employees.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill provides that up to six nonprofessional employees  
14 of each statewide elected official shall be exempt from the  
15 merit system and that the exempt classification of other  
16 employees of statewide elected officials shall be based upon  
17 their classification as of June 30, 1994.
