A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for the crediting of moneys to the rebuild Iowa
2 infrastructure fund.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

HF 584

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1 Section 1. REBUILD IOWA INFRASTRUCTURE FUND. On or after
2 July 1, 1995, the department of management shall estimate the
3 amount of funds that would be credited to the Iowa economic
4 emergency fund from the ending balance of the general fund of
5 the state at the close of the fiscal year beginning July 1,
6 1994, following the appropriation to the cash reserve fund and
7 payment of the items in the schedule submitted in the
8 governor's budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995,
9 pursuant to the provisions of section 8.57. If funds are
10 estimated to be available to be credited to the Iowa economic
11 emergency fund, the department shall credit not more than
12 \$50,000,000 of the ending balance to the rebuild Iowa
13 infrastructure fund and the amount to be credited to the Iowa
14 economic emergency fund made pursuant to section 8.57,
15 subsection 2, is reduced accordingly. The credit to the
16 infrastructure fund shall be made at the time the estimate is
17 made under this section. If the amount credited to the
18 infrastructure fund pursuant to this section is less than
19 \$50,000,000 but the amount of the shortfall is available at
20 the time the credit to the Iowa economic emergency fund is to
21 be made, the shortfall amount shall be credited to the
22 infrastructure fund and any remaining moneys shall be credited
23 to the Iowa economic emergency fund.

24 EXPLANATION

25 This bill provides for the crediting of moneys to the
26 rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund. The bill requires the
27 department of management to estimate the amount of moneys that
28 would be credited to the Iowa economic emergency fund
29 following the deposits to the cash reserve fund and the
30 payment of the schedule submitted by the governor for purposes
31 of eliminating Iowa's deficit under generally accepted
32 accounting principles (GAAP). Current law in section 8.57
33 provides that the general assembly may provide for transfer of
34 moneys to the infrastructure fund in lieu of appropriation to
35 the Iowa economic emergency fund. The bill provides for

1 crediting of \$50,000,000 and for adjustments if estimates are
2 less than that amount.

RELATING TO STATE APPROPRIATION MATTERS BY PROVIDING FOR THE CREDITING OF MONEYS TO THE REBUILD IOWA INFRASTRUCTURE FUND, REVISING EDUCATION APPROPRIATION PROVISIONS, AND OTHER PROPERLY RELATED MATTERS, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. REBUILD IOWA INFRASTRUCTURE FUND. On or after July 1, 1995, the department of management shall estimate the amount of funds that would be credited to the Iowa economic emergency fund from the ending balance of the general fund of the state at the close of the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1994, following the appropriation to the cash reserve fund and payment of the items in the schedule submitted in the governor's budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995, pursuant to the provisions of section 8.57. If funds are estimated to be available to be credited to the Iowa economic emergency fund, the department shall credit not more than \$50,000,000 of the ending balance to the rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund and the amount to be credited to the Iowa economic emergency fund made pursuant to section 8.57, subsection 2, is reduced accordingly. The credit to the infrastructure fund shall be made at the time the estimate is made under this section. If the amount credited to the infrastructure fund pursuant to this section is less than \$50,000,000 but the amount of the shortfall is available at the time the credit to the Iowa economic emergency fund is to be made, the shortfall amount shall be credited to the infrastructure fund and any remaining moneys shall be credited to the Iowa economic emergency fund.

Sec. 2. Of the moneys appropriated to the state board of regents and allocated to Iowa state university of science and technology for the agricultural experiment station for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995, and ending June 30, 1996, in 1995 Iowa Acts, Senate File 266, if enacted by the general assembly, \$100,000 shall be expended to support a beginning farmer center as provided in section 266.39E.

Sec. 3. 1995 Iowa Acts, Senate File 266, section 1, subsection 11, unnumbered paragraph 2, if enacted, is amended to read as follows:

Of the funds appropriated in this subsection, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995, and ending June 30, 1996, \$50,000 shall ~~may~~ be expended for purposes of employing an individual to administer and direct the career ~~opportunities~~ pathways program. The individual employed shall possess a background in business and secondary and postsecondary education.

Sec. 4. 1995 Iowa Acts, House File 579, section 12, if enacted by the General Assembly, is amended to read as follows:

SEC. 12. GENERAL FUND SALARY MONEYS. Funds appropriated from the general fund of the state in this Act relate only to salaries supported from general fund appropriations of the state except for employees of the state board of regents. It is the intent of the general assembly that the department of management and the legislative fiscal bureau in conjunction with the state agency affected by this section shall prepare recommendations concerning the application of this section and present them to the general assembly not later than February 1, 1996.

Sec. 5. Notwithstanding the number of full-time equivalent positions authorized for the department of education for general administration in 1995 Iowa Acts, Senate File 266, if enacted by the general assembly, the department shall be authorized 94.95 FTEs for general administration for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995, and ending June 30, 1996. The additional 1.0 FTE shall be funded from moneys transferred

in 1995 Iowa Acts, Senate File 266 to the department of education from additional funds transferred from phase I to phase III for development of a K-12 and community college management information system. The provision in 1995 Iowa Acts, Senate File 266, requiring the department of education to devote one full-time equivalent position under general administration to direct and administer the management information system, is void.

Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
