1 Section 1. Section 321.34, Code 1995, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:

18. SILVER OR BRONZE STAR PLATES. 3 NEW SUBSECTION. The 4 owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration pursuant to 5 section 321.109, subsection 1, multipurpose vehicle, light 6 delivery truck, panel delivery truck, or pickup, who was 7 awarded a silver or a bronze star by the United States 8 government, may upon written application to the department and 9 presentation of satisfactory proof of the award of the silver 10 or bronze star, order special registration plates. The design 11 of the plates shall include a representation of a silver or 12 bronze star centered on the left side of the plate. The 13 plates shall be numbered in sequence beginning with 00001. 14 The application is subject to approval by the department in 15 consultation with the adjutant general. The special 16 registration plates shall be issued to the applicant in 17 exchange for the registration plates previously issued to that 18 person. The fee for the silver or bronze star plates shall be 19 twenty-five dollars which shall be in addition to the regular 20 annual registration fee. The department shall validate the 21 special plates in the same manner as regular registration 22 plates are validated under this section.

23 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This bill takes effect on January 24 1, 1996.

EXPLANATION

-1-

This bill provides for the issuance of silver or bronze 7 star motor vehicle registration plates to a recipient of a 8 silver or bronze star by the United States government. This 9 bill is effective January 1, 1996.
