HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 A Joint Resolution making an appropriation for the construction
- of a women in the military service memorial.
- 3 WHEREAS, the General Assembly of Iowa finds that it is
- 4 important for a society to recognize and honor the contributions
- 5 of all groups of citizens who have served this nation; and
- 6 WHEREAS, women in military service both now and throughout the
- 7 history of this nation have distinguished themselves as dedicated
- 8 patriots in the cause of freedom; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the history of more than 1,800,000 women who have
- 10 served in our military remains largely untold; and
- 11 WHEREAS, efforts are underway to establish a Women in Military
- 12 Service for America Memorial at the gateway to Arlington National
- 13 Cemetery; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the memorial will commemorate military women's
- 15 dedication, commitment, and sacrifice on behalf of all women
- 16 including the 12,778 Iowa women veterans who have separated from
- 17 the service since 1971; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the state of Iowa strongly supports the establishment
- 19 of the memorial and the work of the Women in Military Service for
- 20 America Memorial Foundation, Inc., the organization which has
- 21 undertaken the task of building this memorial; NOW THEREFORE,

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of 2 the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995, and 3 ending June 30, 1996, to the commission of veterans affairs, 4 the sum of \$2,000, to be donated to the Women in Military 5 Service for America Memorial Foundation for the purpose of 6 constructing the Women in Military Service Memorial to be 7 built at the gateway to Arlington National Cemetery in '8 Arlington, Virginia. The director of the commission of veterans affairs Sec. 2. 10 shall forward this donation to the Women in Military Service 11 for America Memorial Foundation upon certification by the 12 foundation that sufficient funding has been pledged to 13 complete the construction of the memorial. 14 EXPLANATION This joint resolution appropriates \$2,000 from the general 15 16 fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995, 17 and ending June 30, 1996, to the commission of veterans 18 affairs to be donated to the Women in Military Service for 19 America Memorial Foundation to construct an appropriate 20 memorial at the gateway to Arlington National Cemetery in 21 Arlington, Virginia, to pay tribute to the more than 1,800,000 22 women veterans who have served throughout the history of our 23 country. The director of the commission of veterans affairs 24 is required to forward the money when the foundation certifies 25 that sufficient funds have been pledged to complete the 26 construction of the memorial. 27 28 29 30 31 32 33
