HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. /0 1 DAGGETT, GRUBBS, GRUNDBERG, and GRIES 2 BY 3 A Resolution requesting an interim study committee to review state school mandates and the unfunded 4 or underfunded elements of the school aid formula. 5 WHEREAS, local school districts are concerned about 6 7 state mandates that are not funded by the state; and WHEREAS, inequities between school districts are 8 9 increasing because of escalating transportation costs, 10 special needs resulting from declining or increasing 11 enrollments, and the needs of students who are ill-12 prepared to successfully complete the requirements of 13 a standard school curriculum; and WHEREAS, property tax is increasingly relied upon 14 15 both to meet the state's underfunding of special 16 education costs and because of the state's failure to 17 fully fund its obligation to districts that have 18 approved the instructional support levy; and 19 WHEREAS, there is a need for close scrutiny of 20 elements of the school aid formula that increase local 21 property tax burdens; NOW THEREFORE, 22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, 23 That the Legislative Council is requested to establish 24 an interim study committee to review the potential of 25 eliminating certain state school mandates and the

26 unfunded or underfunded elements of the school aid 27 formula. The study committee shall present its 28 recommendations to the General Assembly by December 29 15, 1995.
