

1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 122
2 BY NEUHAUSER AND DVORSKY
3 A Concurrent Resolution honoring University of Iowa Women's
4 Basketball Coach Angie Lee.

5 WHEREAS, University of Iowa Women's Basketball
6 Coach Angie Lee, in her first season as head coach,
7 led the Iowa Hawkeyes to an overall record of 27-4, to
8 the 1995-96 regular season Big Ten Conference Title
9 with a record of 15-1, and to a berth in the Sweet 16
10 in the NCAA Tournament; and

11 WHEREAS, Coach Lee molded her young team into a
12 national power, climbing to as high as fifth in the
13 Associated Press and USA Today Top 25 Polls; and

14 WHEREAS, Coach Lee has been named 1996 Big Ten
15 Coach of the Year, 1996 Associated Press Division I
16 Coach of the Year, 1996 Converse/WBCA District IV
17 Coach of the Year, and 1996 College Sports Magazine
18 Division I Coach of the Year; NOW THEREFORE,

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF
20 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, That Coach Angie Lee be
21 congratulated for the well-deserved honors bestowed
22 upon her and on her outstanding leadership,
23 inspiration, and coaching ability exhibited during the
24 1995-96 basketball season; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Coach Angie Lee, her
26 coaching staff, and the members of the Iowa Hawkeyes
27 Women's Basketball Team be recognized for their
28 achievements and be extended the best wishes of the
29 General Assembly and continued success in the coming
30 seasons; and
