SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 29

A Concurrent Resolution requesting the legislative council to establish an interim committee to study state taxes.

WHEREAS, there is significant interest in Iowa's system of taxation; and

WHEREAS, the Seventy-sixth General Assembly, 1995 Session, has given considerable attention to taxation and associated issues; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, That the legislative council is requested to establish a study of state taxation, including inheritance, income, and sales taxes, and to coordinate the charge of this study with any other tax study established by the council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if a study is established, the committee conducting the study should be directed to report the results of the study to the members of the General Assembly for the 1996 Legislative Session.
