1 Section 1. Section 216A.143, Code 1995, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 216A.143 MEETINGS OF THE COMMISSION.

4 The commission shall meet ~~every-other-month~~ at least once
5 each quarter and may hold special meetings on the call of the
6 chairperson. The commission may adopt rules pursuant to
7 chapter 17A as it deems necessary for the conduct of its
8 business. The members of the commission shall be reimbursed
9 for actual expenses while engaged in their official duties.
10 Members may also be eligible to receive compensation as
11 provided in section 7E.6.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill requires the commission on the status of African-
14 Americans to meet at least once each quarter. Currently, the
15 commission is required to meet once every other month.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MEETINGS OF THE COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF AFRICAN-AMERICANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 216A.143, Code 1995, is amended to read as follows:

216A.143 MEETINGS OF THE COMMISSION.

The commission shall meet every-other-month at least once each quarter and may hold special meetings on the call of the chairperson. The commission may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A as it deems necessary for the conduct of its business. The members of the commission shall be reimbursed for actual expenses while engaged in their official duties.
