1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 267.9 COLLEGE OF VETERINARY  
2 MEDICINE -- LIVESTOCK HEALTH INITIATIVE -- APPROPRIATION.

3 For each fiscal year of the fiscal period beginning July 1,  
4 1995, and ending June 30, 1997, there is appropriated from the  
5 general fund of the state, to the state board of regents for  
6 the Iowa state university college of veterinary medicine one  
7 million five hundred thousand dollars for purposes of  
8 educating veterinary students and postgraduates and assisting  
9 licensed veterinarians, specializing in livestock health and  
10 food animal practice. The moneys shall be expended for  
11 purposes relating to improving livestock health and  
12 production, including but not limited to teaching specialized  
13 skills, expanding infectious disease research, improving  
14 methods for the dissemination of diagnostic information and  
15 other health care data, creating safer meat products, and  
16 increasing the transfer of research results to Iowa companies  
17 involved in livestock health and production. Moneys shall be  
18 expended only after the college receives recommendations for  
19 the expenditure by the council, as provided in section 267.5.  
20 Notwithstanding section 8.33, unencumbered or unobligated  
21 moneys remaining on June 30, 1996, or June 30, 1997, from  
22 moneys appropriated in this section, may be expended until  
23 June 30, 1998, and shall not revert to the general fund of the  
24 state until August 31, 1998.

25 EXPLANATION

26 The bill provides an appropriation from the state general  
27 fund of \$1,500,000 for each of the 1995-1996 and 1996-1997  
28 fiscal years to Iowa state university college of veterinary  
29 medicine. The moneys are to be used for educating veterinary  
30 students and postgraduates and assisting licensed  
31 veterinarians, specializing in livestock health and food  
32 animal practice. Moneys are to be expended only after the  
33 college receives recommendations for the expenditure from the  
34 livestock advisory council. The bill also provides for  
35 delayed reversion of unspent appropriated moneys to the state

1 general fund.

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 267.9 COLLEGE OF VETERINARY  
2 MEDICINE -- LIVESTOCK HEALTH INITIATIVE -- APPROPRIATION.

3 For each fiscal year of the fiscal period beginning July 1,  
4 1995, and ending June 30, 1997, there is appropriated from the  
5 general fund of the state, to the state board of regents for  
6 the Iowa state university college of veterinary medicine one  
7 hundred fifty thousand dollars for purposes of educating  
8 veterinary students and postgraduates and assisting licensed  
9 veterinarians, specializing in livestock health and food  
10 animal practice. The moneys shall be expended for purposes  
11 relating to improving livestock health and production,  
12 including but not limited to teaching specialized skills,  
13 expanding infectious disease research, improving methods for  
14 the dissemination of diagnostic information and other health  
15 care data, creating safer meat products, and increasing the  
16 transfer of research results to Iowa companies involved in  
17 livestock health and production. Moneys shall be expended  
18 only after the college receives recommendations for the  
19 expenditure by the council, as provided in section 267.5.  
20 Notwithstanding section 8.33, unencumbered or unobligated  
21 moneys remaining on June 30, 1996, or June 30, 1997, from  
22 moneys appropriated in this section, may be expended until  
23 June 30, 1998, and shall not revert to the general fund of the  
24 state until August 31, 1998.

25 EXPLANATION

26 The bill provides an appropriation from the state general  
27 fund of \$150,000 for each of the 1995-1996 and 1996-1997  
28 fiscal years to Iowa state university college of veterinary  
29 medicine. The moneys are to be used for educating veterinary  
30 students and postgraduates and assisting licensed  
31 veterinarians, specializing in livestock health and food  
32 animal practice. Moneys are to be expended only after the  
33 college receives recommendations for the expenditure from the  
34 livestock advisory council. The bill also provides for  
35 delayed reversion of unspent appropriated moneys to the state

1 general fund.
