EXPLANATION

The bill repeals a number of unfunded programs administered by the college student aid commission and strikes language requiring a college or university that receives more than \$50,000 for the Iowa college work study program to allocate at least 10 percent of its funding for off-campus public interest student employment.

The unfunded programs repealed under the bill are as follows: the displaced workers financial aid program; programs for loan reimbursement payments for occupational therapists, nurses, and for members of the national guard; and the work for college and educational savings programs. Also repealed are sections relating to optometry school contracts for the right of 10 Iowa optometry students per academic class to study in out-of-state colleges of optometry.

AN ACT

STRIKING CODE LANGUAGE THAT CONFLICTS WITH FEDERAL WORK-STUDY PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND LANGUAGE RELATING TO UNFUNDED PROGRAMS ADMINISTERED BY THE COLLEGE STUDENT AID COMMISSION, AND REPEALING FROM THE CODE CERTAIN UNFUNDED PROGRAMS ADMINISTERED BY THE COLLEGE STUDENT AID COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 261.2, subsections 10 and 14, Code 1995, are amended by striking the subsections.

Sec. 2. Section 261.81, Code 1995, is amended to read as follows:

261.81 WORK-STUDY PROGRAM.

The Iowa college work-study program is established to stimulate and promote the part-time employment of students attending Iowa postsecondary educational institutions, and the part-time or full-time summer employment of students registered for classes at Iowa postsecondary institutions during the succeeding school year, who are in need of employment earnings in order to pursue postsecondary education. The program shall be administered by the commission. The commission shall adopt rules under chapter 17A to carry out the program. The employment under the program shall be employment by the postsecondary education institution itself or work in a public agency or private nonprofit organization under a contract between the institution or the commission and the agency or organization. An-eligible-postsecondary-institution-that-is-allocated-fifty-thousand-dollars-or-more-for-the-work-study-program-by-the-commission-shall-allocate-at-least-ten-percent-of-the-funds-received-for-public-interest-student-employment-in-a-public-agency-or-private-nonprofit-organization-that-is-approved-for
