1 Section 1. Section 321.1, subsection 32, paragraph f, Code  
2 Supplement 1995, is amended to read as follows:

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill amends section 321.1, which provides definitions  
20 for the chapter which provides regulations relating to motor  
21 vehicles and the law of the road. Last year, the general  
22 assembly enacted 1995 Iowa Acts, chapter 56 (Senate File 298),  
23 which in part amended the definition of an "implement of  
24 husbandry" to add machinery towed by a motor vehicle or farm  
25 tractor operated at speeds of less than 30 miles an hour.  
26 This bill amends that section again to provide that the  
27 machinery towed by a motor vehicle or farm tractor does not  
28 have to operate at speeds less than 30 miles per hour. The  
29 bill takes effect upon enactment.

RELATING TO IMPLEMENTS OF HUSBANDRY BY PROVIDING FOR  
MACHINERY TOWED BY A MOTOR VEHICLE OR FARM TRACTOR,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.1, subsection 32, paragraph f, Code Supplement 1995, is amended to read as follows:

f. Self-propelled machinery ~~or machinery towed by a motor vehicle or farm tractor~~ operated at speeds of less than thirty miles per hour or machinery towed by a motor vehicle or farm tractor. The machinery must be specifically designed for, or especially adapted to be capable of, incidental over-the-road and primary off-road usage. In addition, the machinery must be used exclusively for the mixing and dispensing of nutrients to bovine animals fed at a feedlot, or the application of organic or inorganic plant food materials, agricultural limestone, or agricultural chemicals. However, the machinery shall not be specifically designed or intended for the transportation of such nutrients, plant food materials, agricultural limestone, or agricultural chemicals.
