A BILL FOR

1 An Act appropriating moneys from the general fund of the state to  
2 construct, repair, or renovate memorials and monuments  
3 commemorating participants in wars on the state capitol  
4 complex.

1 Section 1. SOLDIERS AND SAILORS MONUMENT OF THE CIVIL WAR  
2 -- REPAIR AND RENOVATION. There is appropriated from the  
3 general fund of the state to the department of general  
4 services for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1996, and  
5 ending June 30, 1997, the following amount, or so much thereof  
6 as is necessary, to be used for the following purpose:

7 To provide for the renovation and repair of the soldiers  
8 and sailors monument of the civil war on the state capitol  
9 complex:

10 ..... \$ 175,000

11 Sec. 2. WORLD WAR II VETERANS MEMORIAL -- PLANNING AND  
12 CONSTRUCTION APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated from the  
13 general fund of the state to the department of general  
14 services for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1996, and  
15 ending June 30, 1997, the following amount, or so much thereof  
16 as is necessary, to be used for the following purpose:

17 To provide for the planning, siting, and construction of a  
18 world war II veterans memorial:

19 ..... \$ 1,000,000

20 The capitol planning commission is responsible for the  
21 planning and siting for a world war II veterans memorial on  
22 the state capitol complex.

23 Sec. 3. REVERSION OF FUNDS. Notwithstanding section 8.33,  
24 any unencumbered or unobligated funds appropriated in section  
25 1 or 2 of this Act which remain on June 30, 1999, shall revert  
26 to the general fund of the state on August 31, 1999.

27 EXPLANATION

28 This bill appropriates for the 1996-1997 fiscal year from  
29 the general fund of the state to the department of general  
30 services \$175,000 to repair and renovate the soldiers and  
31 sailors monument of the civil war and \$1,000,000 to plan,  
32 site, and construct a world war II veterans memorial on the  
33 state capitol complex.

34 The capitol planning commission is responsible for planning  
35 and siting the world war II veterans memorial.

1 Because capitol project appropriations have no reversion  
2 date, the bill also reverts any unobligated or unencumbered  
3 funds remaining from the construction or renovation projects  
4 after three years.
