A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the membership and method of appointment of
2 the statewide police and fire retirement system and providing
3 an effective date.

1 Section 1. Section 411.36, subsection 1, paragraphs a, b,
2 c, and d, Code 1995, as amended by 1995 Iowa Acts, Senate File
3 45, section 3, are amended to read as follows:

4 a. Two fire fighters from different participating cities,
5 one of whom is an active member of the retirement system and
6 one of whom is a retired member. The fire fighters shall be
7 appointed by the governor from a list of at least three names
8 submitted by the governing body of the Iowa association of
9 professional fire fighters.

10 b. Two police officers from different participating
11 cities, one of whom is an active member of the retirement
12 system and one of whom is a retired member. The police
13 officers shall be appointed by the governor from a list of at
14 least three names submitted by the governing body of the Iowa
15 state police association.

16 c. The city treasurers of four participating cities, one
17 of whom is from a city having a population of less than forty
18 thousand, and three of whom are from cities having a
19 population of forty thousand or more. The city treasurers
20 shall be appointed by the governor from a list of at least
21 three names submitted by the governing body of the Iowa league
22 of cities.

26 Sec. 2. Section 411.36, subsection 2, Code 1995, is
27 amended to read as follows:

28 ~~2. Except-as-otherwise-provided-for-the-initial~~
29 ~~appointments,-the~~ The voting members, except for the treasurer
30 of state or the treasurer's designee, shall be appointed by
31 the governor, subject to confirmation by the senate, for four-
32 year terms, and the nonvoting members shall be appointed for
33 two-year terms. Terms begin on May 1 in the year of
34 appointment and expire on April 30 in the year of expiration.

35 Sec. 3. Section 411.36, subsection 5, paragraph a, Code

1 1995, is amended to read as follows:

2 a. Members of the board, except the treasurer of state or
3 the treasurer's designee, shall be paid their actual and
4 necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties
5 and shall receive a per diem as specified in section 7E.6 for
6 each day of service. Per diem and expenses shall be paid to
7 voting members from the fire and police retirement fund
8 created in section 411.8.

9 Sec. 4. EXPIRATION OF TERMS OF OFFICE OF BOARD. The terms
10 of office of members of the board of trustees for the
11 statewide fire and police retirement system serving on the
12 effective date of this Act shall continue until their
13 expiration, except that the term of office of the citizen
14 member shall expire on May 1, 1995, and the treasurer of
15 state, or the treasurer's designee, shall become a member of
16 the board on that date.

17 Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
18 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill provides for changes in appointment and
21 membership of members of the board of trustees of the
22 statewide police and fire retirement system. The voting
23 members presently appointed by the Iowa association of
24 professional fire fighters, the Iowa state police association,
25 and the Iowa league of cities will be appointed by the
26 governor from lists of names submitted by the associations and
27 the league and will be subject to senate confirmation under
28 the bill. The bill replaces the citizen member with the
29 treasurer of state. The term of office of the citizen member
30 expires on May 1, 1995, and the terms of the remaining voting
31 members expire with the expiration of the terms to which they
32 were appointed under the bill. The bill takes effect upon
33 enactment.
