3 establishing a penalty.

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 321.473A ANNUAL PERMIT FEE FOR
2 OPERATORS OF MOTOR TRUCKS TRANSPORTING SOLID WASTE.

3 The operator of a motor truck, which is not registered
4 within the state, which transports solid waste, as defined in
5 section 455B.301, to a sanitary disposal project or sanitary
6 landfill located within this state, shall not transport solid
7 waste in this state unless the operator obtains an annual
8 permit by paying an annual fee to the department. The
9 department shall determine the amount of the annual fee and
10 shall grant a permit as determined by rule. A permit shall be
11 effective for not more than one year from the date of
12 issuance. The operator of a motor truck which transports
13 solid waste without a permit in violation of this section
14 commits a simple misdemeanor. Each transport of solid waste
15 in violation of this section constitutes a separate offense.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill requires the operator of a motor truck, which is
18 not registered within the state, which transports solid waste
19 to a sanitary disposal project or sanitary landfill located
20 within this state, to obtain an annual permit by paying an
21 annual fee to the state department of transportation. The
22 department shall determine the amount of the annual fee and
23 shall grant a permit as determined by rule. The operator of a
24 motor truck which transports solid waste without a permit in
25 violation of the bill commits a simple misdemeanor. Each
26 transport of solid waste in violation of the bill constitutes
27 a separate offense.
