1 An Act requiring the posting of notice of par sheet theoretical  
2 payout averages for slot machines in racetrack enclosures and  
3 excursion gambling boats.

1 Section 1. Section 99F.4, Code 1995, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 22. To specify the style and size of  
4 public notices, not less than twelve inches by eighteen  
5 inches, which notify the patrons of the racetrack enclosures  
6 and the excursion gambling boats of the par sheet theoretical  
7 averages for payouts of slot machines operating in those  
8 gambling facilities. The public notices shall show the par  
9 sheet theoretical averages for slot machine payouts by  
10 denomination of coins or dollars and the overall theoretical  
11 average for each racetrack enclosure and excursion gambling  
12 boat. The commission shall provide that the public notices  
13 are posted in locations conspicuous to the patrons of the  
14 gambling facilities.

15 Sec. 2. Section 99F.7, subsection 16, Code Supplement  
16 1995, is amended by striking the subsection.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill provides that the state racing and gaming  
19 commission shall adopt rules specifying the style and size of  
20 public notices, not less than 12 inches by 18 inches, which  
21 show the par sheet theoretical averages of slot machines at a  
22 racetrack enclosure or excursion gambling boat by denomination  
23 of coin or dollars and the overall theoretical average for  
24 each gambling facility. The commission shall also provide for  
25 the conspicuous location of the public notices.
