The estimate for Senate File 2423 is hereby submitted as a fiscal note pursuant to Joint Rule 17 and as a correctional impact statement pursuant to Section 2.56, Code of Iowa. Senate File 2423 prohibits a person from soliciting another person to arrange a sex act with a child. A person violating this prohibition commits a Class "D" felony.

ASSUMPTIONS

Sufficient information is not available to estimate the number of offenses or convictions.

CORRECTIONAL IMPACT

Senate File 2423 defines a new offense, which may result in a potential impact to the correctional system. However, the exact impact on prison population cannot be determined. It is anticipated that any impact would not be significant.

FISCAL IMPACT

Sufficient information is not available to estimate the fiscal impact of Senate File 2423. However, any impact is not anticipated to be significant.
