A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to boilers and unfired steam pressure vessels by
2 providing for the inspection of certain unfired steam pressure
3 vessels, the procedure for adopting rules, and providing an
4 effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 89.5, Code 1995, is amended by adding
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 4. A rule adopted pursuant to this
4 section which adopts standards by reference to another
5 publication shall be exempt from the requirements of section
6 17A.6, subsection 4, if the following conditions exist:

7 a. The cost of the publication is an unreasonable expense
8 when compared to the anticipated usage of the publication.

9 b. A copy of the publication is available from an entity
10 located within the state capitol complex.

11 c. The rule identifies the location where the publication
12 is available.

13 d. The administrative rules coordinator approves the
14 exemption.

15 Sec. 2. PRESSURE VESSEL INTERNAL INSPECTIONS -- EXTENSION.

16 Notwithstanding section 89.3, unfired steam pressure vessels
17 used as dryer rollers, steam condensate separators, or
18 condensate receivers, manufactured on or after January 1,
19 1994, with an allowable pressure of one hundred fifty pounds
20 per square inch and the safety relief valve set at a pressure
21 of one hundred fifty pounds per square inch, shall be
22 inspected externally on an annual basis and shall be inspected
23 internally for the second time before December 31, 1997.

24 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 1 of this Act, being
25 deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

26 EXPLANATION

27 Section 1 of this bill provides that the labor
28 commissioner, when the commissioner adopts rules concerning
29 boilers and unfired steam pressure vessels that adopt
30 standards by reference to another publication, is exempt from
31 the requirement that the publication referenced be deposited
32 in the state law library under certain conditions. The bill
33 provides that the requirement to deposit the publication in
34 the state law library is waived if the administrative rules
35 coordinator agrees, the cost of compliance is unreasonable,

1 the rule identifies the location of the publication, and the
2 publication is available within the state capitol complex.

3 This section of the bill takes effect upon enactment.

4 Section 2 is a temporary provision of law which provides
5 for the inspection of certain unfired steam pressure vessels
6 manufactured on or after January 1, 1994, with an allowable
7 pressure of 150 pounds per square inch and the safety relief
8 valve set at 150 pounds per square inch. The bill requires
9 that these vessels have an annual external inspection and a
10 second internal inspection completed before December 31, 1997.

AN ACT

RELATING TO BOILERS AND UNFIRED STEAM PRESSURE VESSELS BY PROVIDING FOR THE INSPECTION OF CERTAIN UNFIRED STEAM PRESSURE VESSELS, THE PROCEDURE FOR ADOPTING RULES, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 89.5, Code 1995, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 4. A rule adopted pursuant to this section which adopts standards by reference to another publication shall be exempt from the requirements of section 17A.6, subsection 4, if the following conditions exist:

- The cost of the publication is an unreasonable expense when compared to the anticipated usage of the publication.
- A copy of the publication is available from an entity located within the state capitol complex.
- The rule identifies the location where the publication is available.
- The administrative rules coordinator approves the exemption.

Sec. 2. PRESSURE VESSEL INTERNAL INSPECTIONS -- EXTENSION. Notwithstanding section 89.3, unfired steam pressure vessels used as dryer rollers, steam condensate separators, or condensate receivers, manufactured on or after January 1, 1994, with an allowable pressure of one hundred fifty pounds per square inch and the safety relief valve set at a pressure of one hundred fifty pounds per square inch, shall be

inspected externally on an annual basis and shall be inspected internally for the second time before December 31, 1997.

Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 1 of this Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
