A BILL FOR 1 An Act relating to motorcycle education and providing an effective date and a retroactive applicability provision. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.189, subsection 7, paragraphs a and 2 b, Code 1995, are amended to read as follows:
- 3 a. An operator who has been issued a class M license prior
- 4 to July-1,-1994 May 1, 1997.
- 5 b. An operator who is renewing the operator's class M
- 6 license issued prior to July-17-1994 May 1, 1997.
- 7 Sec. 2. 1994 Iowa Acts, chapter 1102, section 4, as
- 8 amended by 1994 Iowa Acts, chapter 1199, section 52, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. The provisions of this Act which
- 11 amend section 321.189, take effect May 1, ±995 1997.
- 12 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICABILITY. This Act, being
- 13 deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment
- 14 and applies retroactively to May 1, 1995, in order to delay
- 15 the effective date of the amendments to section 321.189,
- 16 subsection 7, Code 1993, to May 1, 1997.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- During the 1994 legislative session, section 321.189,
- 19 subsection 7, was amended to require that all persons applying
- 20 for a driver's license valid for operation of a motorcycle
- 21 must take a motorcycle education course before the license
- 22 would be issued. Persons who already had class M licenses
- 23 issued prior to July 1, 1994, were excepted from the
- 24 requirement. This bill changes the effective date from May 1,
- 25 1995, to May 1, 1997, and changes the persons who are excepted
- 26 from the requirements to those who had class M licenses prior
- 27 to the new effective date of May 1, 1997.
