1 Section 1. Section 902.7, Code 1995, is amended to read as  
2 follows:

3 902.7 MINIMUM SENTENCE -- USE POSSESSION OF A FIREARM.

4 At the trial of a person charged with participating in a  
5 forcible felony, if the trier of fact finds beyond a  
6 reasonable doubt that the person is guilty of a forcible  
7 felony and that the person represented that the person was in  
8 the immediate possession and control of a firearm, ~~displayed a~~  
9 ~~firearm in a threatening manner,~~ or was armed with a firearm  
10 while participating in the forcible felony the convicted  
11 person shall serve a minimum of five years of the sentence  
12 imposed by law. A person sentenced pursuant to this section  
13 shall not be eligible for parole until the person has served  
14 the minimum sentence of confinement imposed by this section.

15 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 902.7A FORCIBLE FELONY SENTENCE --  
16 USE CR DISPLAY OF A FIREARM.

17 At the trial of a person charged with participating in a  
18 forcible felony, if the trier of fact finds beyond a  
19 reasonable doubt that the person is guilty of a forcible  
20 felony and that the person used a firearm or displayed the  
21 firearm in a threatening manner while participating in the  
22 forcible felony, the person shall serve the person's sentence  
23 as follows:

24 1. If the forcible felony is a class "B" felony or  
25 greater, the person shall serve not less than twenty years of  
26 the sentence and shall not be eligible for parole until the  
27 person has served the twenty years.

28 2. If the forcible felony is a class "C" or "D" felony,  
29 the person shall be sentenced to and shall serve twenty years,  
30 and shall not be eligible for release until the person has  
31 served the twenty years, notwithstanding any other provision  
32 of law.

EXPLANATION

34 This bill provides a mandatory minimum period of  
35 confinement of 20 years for the commission of a forcible
