1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 70A.1A SALARY LIMITATIONS --
2 CERTAIN DEPARTMENT HEADS AND SUBORDINATE OFFICERS AND
3 EMPLOYEES.

4 1. The directors, principal assistants, and employees of
5 the following departments, boards, and offices shall not
6 receive an annual salary which exceeds eighty percent of the
7 annual salary of the governor:

8 a. Iowa ethics and campaign disclosure board.

9 b. Department of commerce.

10 c. Department of general services.

11 d. Office of the governor.

12 e. Department of inspections and appeals.

13 f. Department of management.

14 g. Department of personnel.

15 h. Department of revenue and finance.

16 i. Office of state-federal relations.

17 2. The annual salaries of the deputy officers and
18 employees of the following state agencies shall not exceed
19 eighty percent of annual salary of the state agency's elected
20 principal officer:

21 a. Office of auditor of state.

22 b. Office of secretary of state.

23 c. Office of treasurer of state.

24 Sec. 2. SALARIES EXCEEDING LIMITS -- TRANSITION.

25 1. On the effective date of this Act, if the salary of an
26 officer or employee of the state departments and offices
27 exceeds the 80 percent limitation as specified in section 1 of
28 this Act, the salary of the officer or employee shall be
29 frozen at that pay rate until the officer's or employee's
30 salary is less than 80 percent of the applicable principal
31 officer's salary. When the officer's or employee's salary is
32 less than an amount which equals the 80 percent limitation,
33 the officer or employee may receive salary adjustments as
34 otherwise provided by law, but total annual salary shall not
35 exceed the 80 percent limitation.
