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1 Section 1. The Iowa department of public health shall hold  
2 a conference regarding domestic violence involving  
3 representatives of the department of human services,  
4 educational institutions, the medical community, businesses,  
5 clergy, and judges involved in domestic violence cases. The  
6 conference shall take testimony regarding domestic violence  
7 issues, including persons who have researched the issue of  
8 domestic violence and the treatment of persons involved in  
9 domestic violence, and shall develop a comprehensive approach  
10 to dealing with domestic violence, including proposals for  
11 legislative changes. The conference shall present its report  
12 to the general assembly by December 1, 1995.

13 The conference shall be funded by private contributions and  
14 an allocation of state funds from the department of public  
15 health for this purpose.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill directs the department of public health to hold a  
18 conference on domestic violence. The conference shall include  
19 representatives of the courts, the department of human  
20 services, educational institutions, the medical community,  
21 businesses, and the clergy. The conference is to take  
22 testimony and present a report to the general assembly  
23 regarding a comprehensive plan to address domestic violence  
24 issues by December 1, 1995. The conference is to be funded by  
25 private contributions and an allocation from the department of  
26 public health.

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1 Section 1. The Iowa department of public health shall hold  
2 a conference regarding domestic violence involving  
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4 appropriate state agencies or departments, educational  
5 institutions, the medical community, businesses, clergy, and  
6 judges involved in domestic violence cases. The conference  
7 shall take testimony regarding domestic violence issues,  
8 including persons who have researched the issue of domestic  
9 violence and the treatment of persons involved in domestic  
10 violence, and shall develop a comprehensive approach to  
11 dealing with domestic violence, including proposals for
