1 Section 1. Section 68B.22, subsection 4, Code 1995, is  
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. r. Gifts of food, beverages, registration,  
4 or scheduled entertainment, with a per person value in excess  
5 of three dollars, which are given to members of the general  
6 assembly and legislative employees at a group event to which  
7 all members of either house or both houses of the general  
8 assembly are invited.

9 Sec. 2. Section 68B.22, subsection 8, Code 1995, is  
10 amended by striking the subsection.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill permits the giving and receiving of gifts of  
13 food, beverages, registration, or scheduled entertainment,  
14 that exceed \$3 in value, by legislators and legislative  
15 employees at group events to which all members of either house  
16 or both houses of the general assembly are invited.
