It is unlawful for the <u>Iowa</u> league of <u>fowa-municipalities</u> <u>cities</u> to provide any form of aid to a political party or to the campaign of a candidate for political or public office. Any person violating or being an accessory to a violation of this section is guilty of a simple misdemeanor.

Sec. 5. Section 411.36, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code 1995, is amended to read as follows:

The city treasurers of four participating cities, one of whom is from a city having a population of less than forty thousand, and three of whom are from cities having a population of forty thousand or more. The city treasurers shall be appointed by the governing body of the <a>Iowa</a> league of Howa-municipalities cities.
